MES One-on-One Edification, Exhortation & Comfort Activation

In this one-on-one activation, you will be given an opportunity to minister to your fellow MES student incorporating teaching tools that you have already activated in the class setting, with a few modifications.

In this activation the prophetic word is to exhort, edify and comfort.

-MES staff has selected the person that you will be your partner for this activation.

There is a beginning and ending of this prophetic activation

- -You decide which of you will share first.
- -Have your recording device ready for accountability

1Corinthian 14:3, "But he who prophesies speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to men.

- -Edification to uplift, improve morally or intellectually,
- -Exhortation encouraging someone to do;
- -Comfort is ease, freedom from pain, prosperity

Still believing and being sensitive to how God speaks to you by hearing, sensing or seeing.

Being willing to practice, and not using phrases like, "thus saith the Lord." Instead use words like this is what I sense, or this is what I feel.

Always keep in mind this is a training school setting and we give each other an opportunity to grow into...becoming through stirring of gifts within each other... a safe place to grow.

- MES staff has selected the person that you will be your partner for this Oneon-One activation of edification, exhortation and comfort; The entire activation should be about 7 minutes divided between both participants
- 2. **Both of you pray** in the Holy Spirit and/or pray with understanding, (1-2 minutes) inviting the Holy Spirit to minister through you for your partner.
- 3. **Go silent,** and the person selected to go first begin sharing; and allowing time for your partner to share.
- 4. Write out the essence of the word you received from your recording. Write the time the activation began and the time it ended.
